Responsible to: Room Leaders / Nursery Manager

Purpose of Job: To work as a keyperson and as part of the nursery team under the direction of the nursery manager/room leaders to provide safe, high-quality education and care for babies and young children.

Main Duties:

- 1. To assist with the planning of the curriculum to meet the needs of individual children in line with the EYFS.
- 2. To set up the room for the daily activities and to clear/prepare the room for the next session this includes lunchtime provisions and outside activities.
- 3. To act as a keyperson to a small group of children, liaising closely with parents/carers and ensuring each child's needs are recognised and met and to maintain appropriate observations and records, with regards to eating, sleeping, changing, play and development. Meeting the EYFS requirements.
- 4. To have the ability to use ICT and submit information electronically.
- 5. To work with parents and outside agencies to provide a safe caring and stimulating learning environment for all children.
- 6. To advise the nursery manager/room leaders of any concerns, e.g. over children, parents or the safety of equipment, preserving confidentiality as necessary.
- 7. To teach, play and interact with children/babies, offering an appropriate level of support and stimulation, ensuring that all children/babies are supervised at all times.
- 8. Change children who have wet or soiled clothing/nappies.
- 9. To attend staff meetings, training courses and in-house training when required. Also attend Association meetings when required to do so and support any fundraising events.
- 10. To carry out any cleaning jobs that are required.
- 11. To keep completely confidential any information regarding the children, their families or other staff which is gained as part of the job, and to sign a confidentiality agreement to that end.
- 12. Work within the agreed Policies and Procedures for the nursery

- Good understanding of EYFS and child development and how to apply it in practice

- Ability to work as part of a team and to use own initiative
- Ability to use common sense and recognise quality provision
